## 24hr BP Monitor Appointment Please ensure you return the monitor the following day before 3pm.

## Your appointment

Your appointment will be held at a GP surgery which offers free parking. Finding free spaces can sometimes be difficult so please leave plenty of time.

If you need to cancel or re-arrange your appointment, please call **01420 560817**.

- You will be seen by a cardiac physiologist who will fit the monitor for you and show you how it works. You will not see a doctor at this appointment.
- It would be most helpful if you could wear clothing that has fairly wide or flexible sleeves so that the cuff worn underneath has room to inflate.
- The blood pressure cuff will inflate approximately every half hour during the day and hourly at night.
- After the device is fitted you can return home and carry on the usual daily routine, you will <u>not</u> be able to have a shower or bath during this period as the device must be kept dry.
- We do not advise driving, other than to and from the appointment, as the BP monitor can be a distraction.
- Fitting the monitor will take approximately 15 minutes.

The result will be reviewed by a cardiology doctor and a letter will be sent to your GP. If you need to be seen by the doctor you will be offered a further appointment in the cardiology clinic at one of our community locations.
